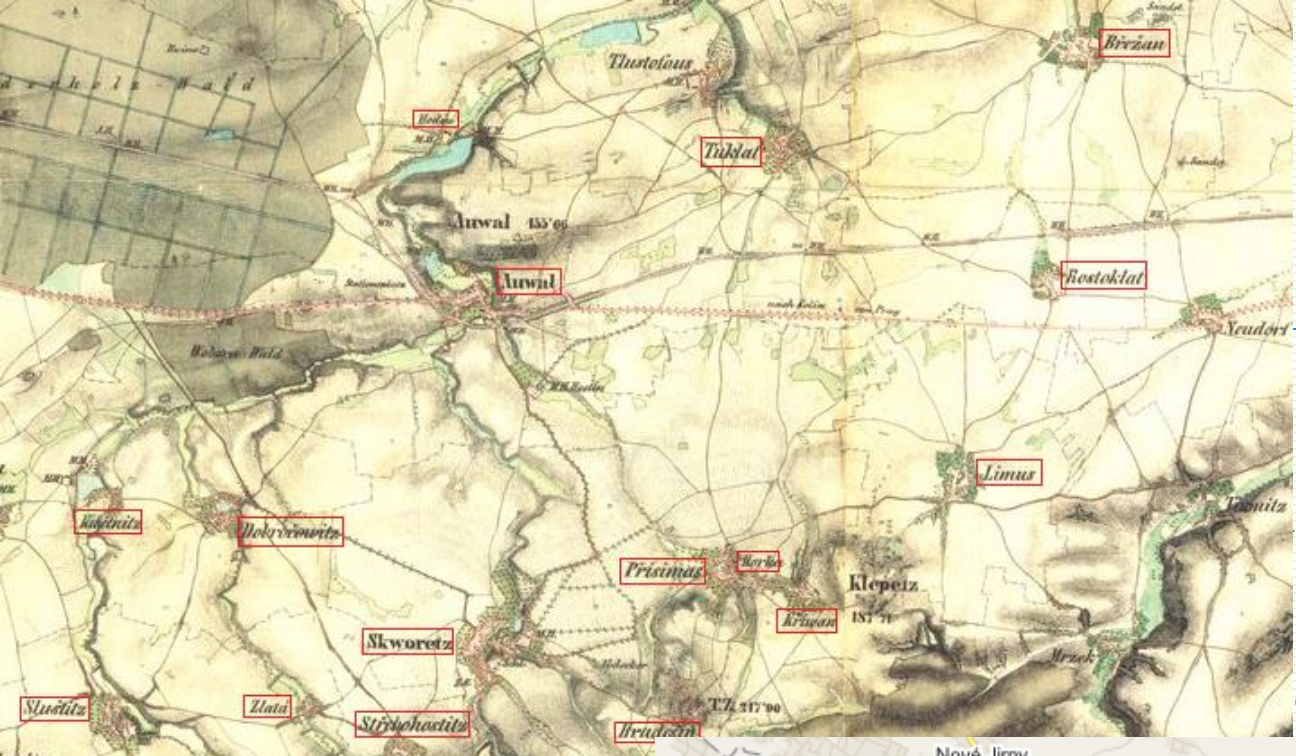

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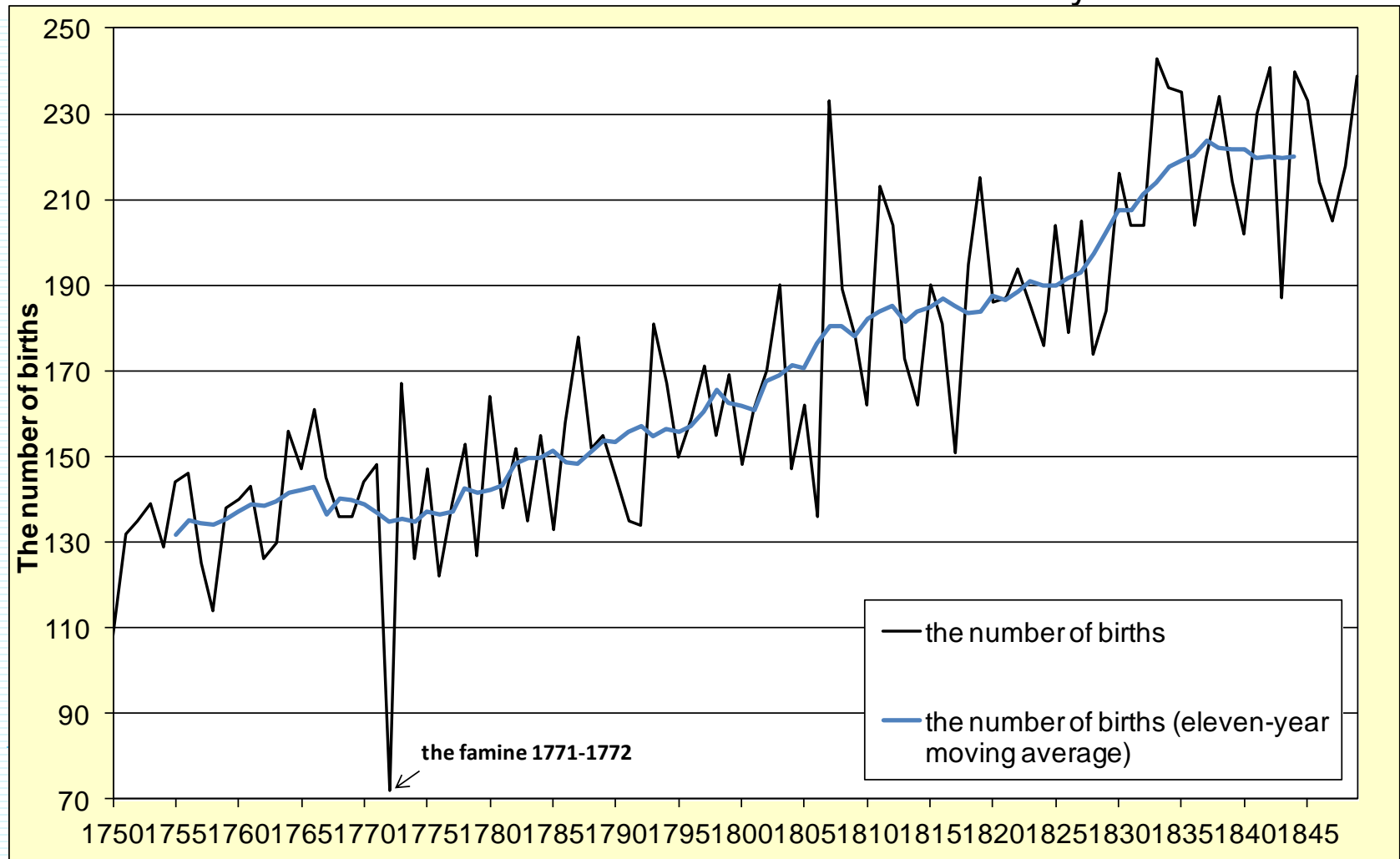

 - 1. 6. 1811 the General Civil Code
 - 9. 9. 1848 the abolition of serfdom

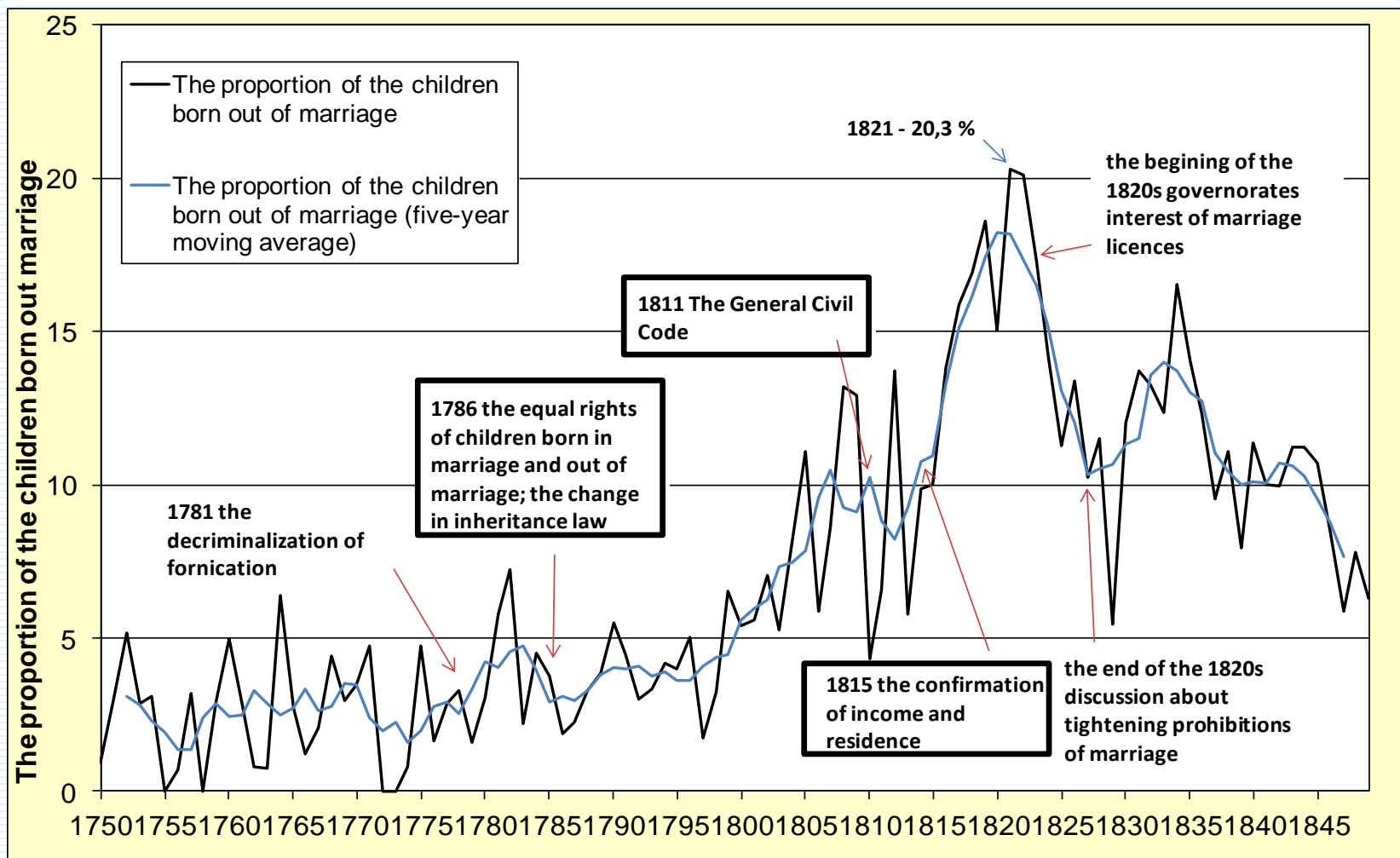

Single father

- the information available only if child born out of marriage was legitimized
 - claim responsibility for fatherhood or the marriage with the mother
 - the legitimation of 23.2 % of children born out of marriage
